

# Apply now



The next *impulse* programme runs from 29 April to 11 July 2025 at the Maxwell Centre, University of Cambridge.

### Application deadline: 3 February 2025 (first round)

All candidates need to complete an online application form to apply for the *impulse* programme. For the best chance to be matched with an available Fellowship, we recommend making an application in the first round.

Second round applications close on 3 March 2025.

Applicants will be interviewed via video call ahead of acceptance to the programme.

### Programme fees

Fellowships are available from our Partners for specific technology and research areas.

#### For self-funded places:

- > Cambridge University students and staff: £1,500
- > External participants: £5,000

The above fees cover the programme and catering. Accommodation, travel costs and daily allowance are not included.
